Ordinary TIME

AKA: SUNDAYS OF THE YEAR

The word ordinary comes from the same word as ordinal and refers to the numbering of Sundays during the Church Year that fall outside of the major seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter. There are normally 34 Sundays in Ordinary Time, though some are replaced by significant feasts and holy days.

DATE: There are two periods of Ordinary Time. The first is from the Baptism of The Lord until Lent. The second begins after Pentecost and ends with Advent.

SIGNIFICANT FEASTS AND HOLIDAYS: Trinity Sunday, Body and Blood of Christ, Assumption, All Saints, All Souls, Christ the King

LITURGICAL COLOR:

- Green For Ordinary Days
- Red for martyrs

SPIRITUAL GOAL:

- To apply the practice of faith to everyday living
- Grow in grace and holiness
- To teach by word and example the message of the Gospel
