**OUR LADY'S ACADEMY**

We would like to share with you all the fantastic things that we are doing in Pre-K4A. Our theme this past month "All About Me". We have been focusing on what makes us unique on the inside and outside. One of our big projects was based on the story Wemberly Worried by Kevin Henkes. This story is about a young mouse that worries about everything and when school started her worrying became worse. As a class, we began discussing our feelings especially how we felt on the first day of school. The children then recreated their face. We looked at our skin color, eye color and the size and shape of our mouths and noses. The children then filled in the sentence "On the first day of school I felt \_\_\_\_\_." Everyone has different feelings associated with different events. Some of the children felt sad, happy, scared and so on. We talked about how each of us felt and that it is okay to have various feelings because everyone is going through a difference experience. "We Are All Special in God's Eyes" is another project we have put together. Since our theme is "All About Me" we have been learning and finding ways in which we are all unique. God created us and we each have special things about us. We had the children think of and fill in the sentence "God made my \_\_\_\_\_ special." Each child had to think of at least one thing that they felt was special about themselves. They then drew a picture of their special feature and filled in the sentence with invented spelling. This project has been one of my favorites so far. One child said "God made my voice box special." Another said "God made my arms special." Those are just a few of the inventive and fun things that the children said. This project is displayed on our bulletin board outside of our Pre-K 4A classroom. We will be continuing our "All About Me" theme and we will incorporate our them on "Family."
