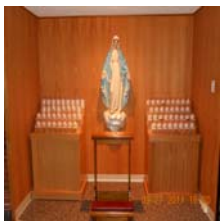

The proposed plan would be implemented over a 3-5 year period. The proposed plan does not consider that we have a parish school.
