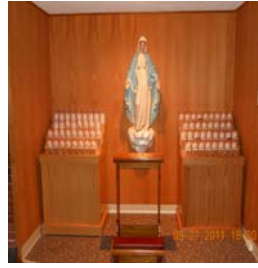

OUR LADY'S ACADEMY NEWS

It is amazing how quickly this school year has gone by. The boys and girls in 2A have been very busy this year learning so many new things. They continue to earn compliments from other teachers and staff members towards their goal of filling up the marble jar. They not too long ago reached the goal of 25 marbles and chose the prize of make your own sundaes.

The 2nd grade children from Our Lady's Academy recently received their First Holy Communion on Sunday May 6th. In preparation for this special day, we spent a lot of time in class, talking about receiving communion. Many children from 2A were able to take part during the Mass on this special day, whether it was doing a reading, the general intercessions, bring the gifts up, or crowning the Statue of Mary.

We recently invited all of the parents in to see the children perform small plays that they had been working on during Reading Workshop. Each group presented an Aesop fable, and at the end of the skit told the moral. The children were all working on improving their fluency skills. On top of that they also created costumes and props for their roles. All of the children did a wonderful job!

In writing we have been working on biographies. As a class the children came up with a list of interview questions. They then were randomly partnered with a classmate to interview them. They enjoyed learning new things about their classmates that they had not known before. At this point they have begun to use the information they gathered to write up the biographies. It is great to see what wonderful writers they have all become.

For our unit in science we focused on Earth and space. The children were so eager and excited to share their own knowledge about this topic, and then to learn more about it. The children in both 2A and 2B are now working together in small groups to research information about each of the planets.

**NEW CORI REFORM LAW**

Every year, all volunteers involved in a parish ministry must fill out a CORI form. This year the form is a bit different as it requires the last 6 digits of your social security number. These forms will be sent home or given to all volunteers over the next few months. Please see below which was sent to us by the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center:

To facilitate the CORI reform law signed by the Governor of the Commonwealth, the Department of Criminal Information Services recently put a new CORI access system in place. This new system called iCORI requires that all individuals provide the last 6 digits of their Social Security number along with other information required on the CORI request form. The form content is sent to the Archdiocese by the Commonwealth for use in requesting CORI. The Archdiocese is certified to access the background of all clergy, seminarians, paid parish staff, all volunteers for parish and school, Religious Education teachers and school personnel. The Archdiocese is required to carry out the CORI process within the confines of the regulations put forth by the CORI Unit.

We appreciate the cooperation of all those required to complete the annual CORI and we particularly thank you for keeping the pledge to protect those among us who are most vulnerable.
