**OUR LADY'S ACADEMY NEWS****Pre-K 4B News – Part 1**

The year continues to rush by much too quickly. I can't believe it's almost May! The children continue to grow and mature as they discover new friendships and learn new concepts.

Spring is a time of re-birth and re-awakening in nature. It is also a wonderful time to begin our study of animals by focusing on birds, eggs and nests. On a beautiful spring day recently the class went on a Nature Walk around the school to collect materials for our nest building project. We not only found sticks and leaves, but a real abandoned bird's nest! We then used paper lunch bags, leaves, twigs, yarn and feathers to create beautiful and unique bird's nests. We read the books Egg to Chicken by Camilla de la Bédoyère and A Chicken's Life by Nancy Dickmann. The children learned about the life-cycle of a chicken and why eggs have to be kept warm before they hatch. This also helped them to understand the importance of building a safe and secure nest.

On April 8<sup>th</sup> local author Terry Golson and her chicken visited the Pre-K classrooms. Before her visit we read Tillie Lays An Egg and used the computer in our classroom to watch a live stream of the new baby chicks on Terry's farm. This was a fun and educational activity for the children. Terry spoke at length about her life on a chicken farm. The children got to see and pet a real live chicken. (It feels like petting a cloud!) We also learned that chickens have ears, they cannot see well in the dark and they like to go to sleep very early in the evening standing on a roost (a ladder like structure.) Terry also showed the children samples of the eggs that were laid by chickens on her farm. They were various sized and colors and looked very different from the eggs we purchase at a grocery store. The children were a very respectful audience and listened very attentively to Ms. Golson's presentation. Thank you to Our Lady's PTO for sponsoring this author visit.
