The Archdiocese of Boston issued the following statement on Friday, May 25, 2012. It was read at all the weekend Masses of May 26/27, 2012.

“The Archdiocese of Boston today announced that it has placed Rev. Joseph F. Byrne on an administrative leave of absence as a result of receiving an allegation of sexual abuse of a child. Fr. Byrne is a [retired priest] Senior Priest with limited ministry in parishes in the Falmouth area on Cape Cod. The allegation concerns conduct alleged to have occurred in the early 1970’s and was only recently reported to the Archdiocese.

The Archdiocese immediately notified law enforcement of the allegation and has initiated a preliminary investigation into the complaint. Fr. Byrne will remain on administrative leave without any public ministry pending the outcome of the preliminary investigation. The decision to place Fr. Byrne on administrative leave represents the Archdiocese’s commitment to the welfare of all parties and does not represent a determination of Fr. Byrne’s guilt or innocence as it pertains to this allegation. The Archdiocese will work to resolve this case as expeditiously as possible and in a manner that is fair to all parties.

“We remain committed to doing everything possible to ensure the safety and well-being of children and young people in our parishes and institutions,” stated Cardinal Seán O’Malley. “I know the faithful and the clergy of the Archdiocese join me in this pledge of prayerful support.””

NEW CORI REFORM LAW

Every year, all volunteers involved in a parish ministry must fill out a CORI form. This year the form is a bit different as it requires the last 6 digits of your social security number. These forms will be sent home or given to all volunteers over the next few months. Please see below which was sent to us by the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center:

To facilitate the CORI reform law signed by the Governor of the Commonwealth, the Department of Criminal Information Services recently put a new CORI access system in place. This new system called iCORI requires that all individuals provide the last 6 digits of their Social Security number along with other information required on the CORI request form. The form content is sent to the Archdiocese by the Commonwealth for use in requesting CORI. The Archdiocese is certified to access the background of all clergy, seminarians, paid parish staff, all volunteers for parish and school, Religious Education teachers and school personnel. The Archdiocese is required to carry out the CORI process within the confines of the regulations put forth by the CORI Unit.

We appreciate the cooperation of all those required to complete the annual CORI and we particularly thank you for keeping the pledge to protect those among us who are most vulnerable.
