NEW KNEELERS

We hope everyone's knees are enjoying the new kneelers! The 217 kneelers cost \$8,366 to purchase. We had received quotes from several vendors ranging from \$16,000 to \$22,000, so we remain vigilant in obtaining the best price possible. We were also very creative in coordinating the project to reduce the overall cost to the parish. We reused the original kneeler framework and our parish custodian provided the onsite labor to fabricate and install the new kneelers. We were thankfully able to start the kneeler replacement project through an initial donation from a parishioner. We hope you too will consider a donation to help defray the cost of these new kneelers along with the continual repairs that are required to keep our church property looking its best! PASTORAL PLANNING UPDATE

Last week the pastors of the Waltham parishes participated in a meeting with our local vicar, Fr. Bob Connors and Fr. Paul Soper who is the current coordinator of the Archdiocesan Planning Office. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the proposed parish alignments for Waltham. None of the five parishes support the original proposal from the Archdiocesan Planning Committee as presented last December which was to combine Our Lady's and St. Mary under one pastor and St. Charles, St. Jude and Sacred Heart under one pastor.

Fr. Soper indicated that the Archdiocese has no interest in imposing a plan on Waltham, or any other community, but rather would like for the five Waltham parishes to agree to a plan that best serves the city's Catholic community. However, a cluster plan for Waltham parishes in some capacity is required by the Archdiocese, which is to be determined to best address the clergy shortage, finances, and the goal of further evangelization.

There are parish clusters within the Archdiocese that are ready to move forward with the proposed clustering plan and this will occur within the next year or so. It was agreed by all that Waltham parishes are not ready to be part of the first round of clustering and will take additional time before any plan can be proposed and implemented.

Our parish proposal of being one parish with one pastor remains our desire due to the growth and evangelization over the past four years, especially in light of a sizeable and growing school and the necessary work which that entails. Greater pastoral connection between the Waltham parishes also remains our desire and goal.

I will keep you updated as this process moves forward and new information is received.
