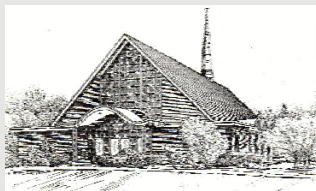

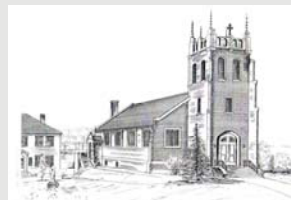

# Remember Your Loved Ones

## Annual Memorial Candles

Purchasing an Annual Memorial Candle to honor a loved one or special intention is a wonderful way to celebrate sentiments while beautifying the sacred space of our church. Our Lady's has two electric candle stands with a total of 68 candles with 34 candles on each side of the Blessed Virgin Mary at the front entrance to our church. One set of candles burns from **May to May** and one set burns from **November to November**.



These stands and candles are warm, inviting and unique. Each candle is made of real wax with electrified illumination to ensure your memorial candle burns brightly all day and night all year long. A small plaque displaying the name of your loved one or a "special intention" will be mounted before each candle. Plaques will remain on display for one year and may be renewed or rededicated for additional 12-month periods. The annual offering for each candle is \$250 which will support the work and needs of Our Lady's Parish.
