





<u>**Catechism Corner</u>** - <u>**The Sacrament of Holy Orders**</u> The whole Church is a priestly people. Through Baptism all the faithful share in the priesthood of Christ. This participation is called the "common Priesthood of the faithful." Based on this common priesthood and ordered to its service, there exists another participation in the mission of Christ: the ministry conferred by the sacrament of Holy Orders, where the task is to serve the People of God by teaching, divine worship and pastoral governance.</u>

Holy Orders is the sacrament through which the mission entrusted by Christ to his apostles continues to be exercised in the Church until the end of time. The sacrament is conferred by the laying on of hands followed by a solemn prayer of consecration asking God to grant the ordinand the graces of the Holy Spirit required for his ministry. Ordination imprints and indelible sacramental character.

The Church confers the sacrament of Holy Orders only on baptized men, whose suitability for the exercise of ministry has been duly recognized. Church authority alone has the responsibility and right to call someone to receive the sacrament of Holy Orders. In the Latin Church it is normally conferred only on candidates who are ready to embrace celibacy freely for the love of God's kingdom and the service of men.
