
11:00am Memorial Weekend Mass - May 25, 2025

Catechism Corner - The Common Good


The common good comprises “the sum total of social conditions which allow people, either as groups or as individuals to reach their fulfillment more fully and more easily.”

The common good consists of three essential elements: respect for and promotion of the fundamental rights of the person; prosperity or the development of the spiritual and temporal goods of society; the peace and security of the group and of its members. The dignity of the human person requires the pursuit of the common good. Everyone should be concerned to create and support institutions that improve the conditions of human life.

It is the role of the state to defend and promote the common good of civil society. The common good of the whole human family calls for an organization of society on the international level.

The Schedule:



