



#### Catechism Corner The Seven Petitions of the Lord's Prayer

After we have placed ourselves in the presence of God our Father to adore and to love and to bless him, the Spirit of adoption stirs up in our heats seven petitions, seven blessings. The first three, draw us toward the glory of the Father. The first series of petitions carries us toward him, for his own sake: thy name, thy kingdom, thy will. It is characteristic of love to think first of the one whom we love. In none of these petitions do we mention ourselves; the burning desire, even anguish, of the beloved Son for his Father's glory seizes us. By these first petitions, we are strengthened in faith, filled with hope, and set aflame by charity.

1st. By asking "hallowed be thy name" we enter into God's plan, the sanctification of his name– revealed first to Moses and then in Jesus-by us and in us, in every nation and in each man.

2nd. By the second petition, the Church looks first to Christ's return and the final coming of the Reign of God. It also prays for the growth of the Kingdom of God in the "today" of our lives.


3rd. In the third petition, we ask our Father to unite our will to that of his Son, so as to fulfill his plan of salvation in the life of the world.

The last four petitions of the Lord's Prayer present our wants to him; they ask that our lives be nourished, healed of sin, and made victorious in the struggle of good over evil. #### **RESTATING THE PAST SCAM REMINDER**




