# **Upcoming Catechism Seminar**

What is it? - A six-week seminar will be offered for parishioners of Our Lady's Parish this autumn to foster learning and understanding of the Catholic faith.

Where will it be? - It will take place at the school conference room, the first room to the right as you enter the main entrance of the school.

When will it take place? - The meetings will be after the 11 am Mass on the Sundays of October 19 and 26 and November 2, 9, 16 and 23. They will begin around 12:15 pm and end in an hour.


How will it be accomplished? - As a wellspring of the Catholic faith, the Catechism of the Catholic Church will be the primary book used. Please obtain a personal copy. Because six weeks of time is not enough to cover the breath and scope of the entire Catechism, the meetings will be held in a seminar style. Parishioners attending the meetings are encouraged to bring topics and questions on the Catechism that they would like to learn more about. One of the parish clergy will offer some insight and provide opportunity for conversation. Please be mindful that the conversation will be moderated by a clergyman because of the short time frame and many topics to discuss. We'll discuss the first 460 paragraphs of the Catechism during the first class on Oct. 19. Why go? - By increasing our knowledge and understanding of the Catholic faith, we equip ourselves with the tools we need to receive the greatest possible gift: to spend eternity with God





# Catechism Corner Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901-1925)

Pier Giorgio Frassati was an Italian young man who was affectionately called the "Man of the Beatitudes" by Saint John Paul II for his exemplary work of bringing comfort and happiness to those who were poor, suffering, meek, hungry, thirsty or in need of mercy and who himself was a clean of heart peace maker, and persecuted for the sake of the Gospel. He died at the young age of 24 while in charitable service to the people who were sick and dying in his community. The Church will canonize him on Sunday September 7, 2025 along with Carlo Acutis, at St. Peter's Square in Rome. His Holiness Pope Leo XIV will preside. This fulfills the dream of Pope Francis to canonize both young men during the Jubilee Holy Year 2025.


