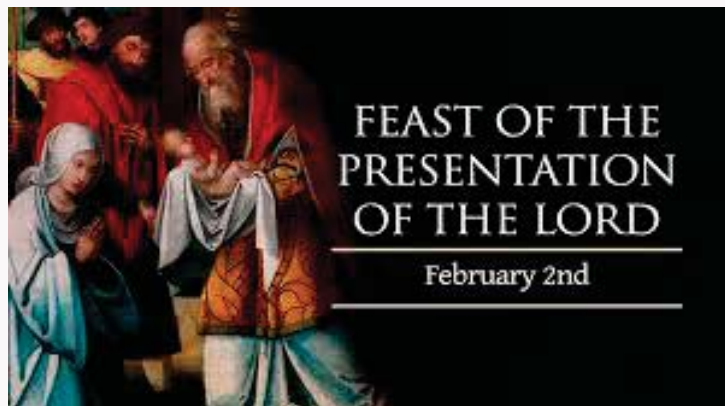

On February 2, 2026 we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord also known as Candlemas Day, which occurs 40 days after the birth of Jesus. On this day Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the Jewish temple for consecration after His birth. The Gospel account speaks of a righteous man named Simeon, who made a prophetic statement about Jesus, calling Him “a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel.” The evangelical image of the Presentation of Jesus in the temple contains the symbol of light, the light that comes from Christ and shines on Mary and Joseph, on Simeon and Anna, and through on everyone. The Fathers of the Church connected this radiance with the spiritual journey.

The 4pm Saturday and the 9am and 11am Sunday Masses will be celebrated. They will not be cancelled due to inclement weather.

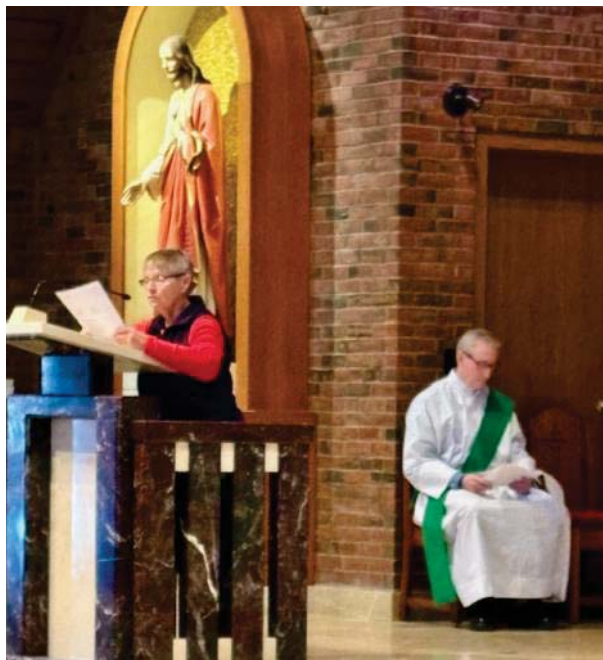

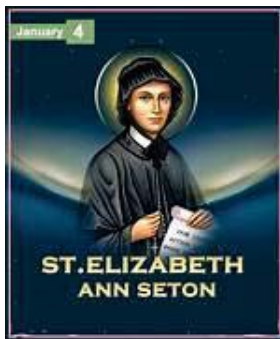

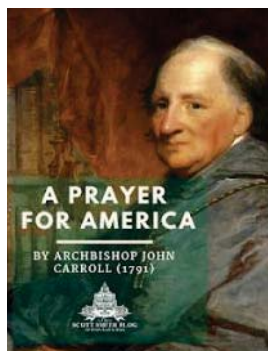

Elizabeth Ann Seton (1774-1821) was the first American-born Catholic Saint. She founded the Sisters of Charity, and the first Catholic School system into the U. S. establishing a legacy of education and service to the poor. Canonized in 1975.



St. John Neumann (1811-1860) Bohemian born priest who immigrated to the U.S. in 1836, becoming the fourth Bishop of Philadelphia in 1852. He founded the first diocesan Catholic School system in the U.S. Was canonized in 1977 becoming the first male U.S. citizen to be named a Saint. Recognized as patron saint of educators and teachers.



Archbishop John Carroll

(1735-1815) was the first Roman Catholic Bishop and Archbishop in the U.S. He was a Jesuit priest, born in Maryland who founded Georgetown University in 1789 establishing the first Catholic Institution of higher learning in the U.S.
