#### CATECHISM CORNER

#### THE ANGELS

The existence of the spiritual, non-corporeal beings that Sacred Scripture usually calls "angels" is a truth of faith. St. Augustine says: "Angel' is the name of their office, not of their nature. If you seek the name of their nature, it is 'spirit'; if you seek the name of their office, it is 'angel'; from what they are, 'spirit' from from what they do 'angel."

Angels are spiritual creatures who glorify God without ceasing and who serve his saving plans for other creatures. They have intelligence and will: they are personal and immortal creatures, surpassing in perfection all visible creatures, as the splendor of their glory bears witness. They belong to Christ because they were created through and for him: "for in him all things were created in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or authorities – all things were created through him and for him." The angels surround Christ their Lord. They serve him especially in the accomplishment of his saving mission to men. The Church venerates the angels who help her on her earthly pilgrimage and protect every human being. From its' beginning until death, human life is surrounded by their watchful care and intercession. "Beside each believer stands an angel protector and shepherd leading him to life."
