CATECHISM CORNER

THE TRADITION OF PRAYER

Prayer should accompany the reading of Sacred Scripture, so that a dialogue takes place between God and man. For "we speak to him when we pray; we listen to him when we read the divine oracles."

The Word of God, the liturgy of the Church, and the virtues of faith, hope, and charity are sources of prayer.

Prayer is primarily addressed to the Father, it can also be directed toward Jesus, particularly by the invocation of his holy name: "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on us sinners."


The Church invites us to invoke the Holy Spirit as the interior Teacher of Christian prayer. Because of Mary's singular cooperation with the action of the Holy Spirit the Church loves to pray in communion with the Virgin Mary, to magnify with her the great things the Lord has done for her, and to entrust supplications and praises to her.

The most appropriate places for prayer are personal or family oratories, monasteries, places of pilgrimage, and above all the church, which is the proper place for liturgical prayer for the parish community and the privileged place for Eucharistic adoration.


