

Saint Vincent de Paul (1581-1660) was a French peasant who became a priest and dedicated his life to charitable work, founding the Congregation of the Mission (Vincentians) and co-founded the Daughters of Charity to serve the poor and the sick.

The Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul is an international religious community founded in Paris, France in 1633 by St. Vincent de Paul and St. Louise de Marillac. The Daughters of Charity continue to serve people who are poor and marginalized with humility, simplicity and charity. Today, nearly 400 years later, The Company of the Daughters of Charity of St Vincent de Paul, Servants of the Poor continues to serve people who are poor and marginalized with humility, simplicity and charity. About 14,000 daughters of Charity currently work in 97 countries across Africa, Asia. Europe, Latin America, Oceania and North America, living among and working with those who are abandoned, neglected or poor. Sister Barbara Ann Curran, Fr. DiPerri's aunt is a Daughter of Charity. She visits Our Lady's when she is home to see the family. We thank her and commend her for her dedicated work with the Daughters of Charity.









#### St. Padre Pio - Feast Day September 23

Padre Pio of Pietrelcina, Italy was born in 1866 and died in 1968. As a boy he could see guardian angels and spoke with Jesus and Mother Mary. He became a Capuchin monk and was later ordained a priest serving at his monastery in Pietrelcina. Padre Pio was a mystic and was blessed by God, as he fully cooperated in following God's will even at great cost to him. When presiding at Mass he would be in a state of ecstasy for hours. He could bilocate (be in two places at the same time), and had the ability to read a persons' heart and spiritual visions, and performed many miracles of healing. The Stigmata (the 5 wounds of Jesus) appeared on his body September 20, 1898. The wounds smelled of roses, bled constantly and caused him tremendous pain. In the year 2002 Padre Pio was canonized a Saint.


